FROM I-91: Take Exit 22N, onto Rte. 9. Follow Rte. 9 to exit 28. Follow Rte. 72W to Corbin Ave, exit 7. At exit light, turn right, proceed to next light, and turn right onto West Main St. One block after the third light, turn right after Bank of America onto Lexington St. Museum and free parking lot are on the left.

FROM I-84: Take Exit 35 (left exit) onto Rte. 72E. Follow signs to New Britain and take Columbus Blvd, exit 8. At the exit light, turn right and proceed to the next light. Take a right onto West Main Street. Take a left before Bank of America onto Lexington St. Museum and free parking lot are on the left.
